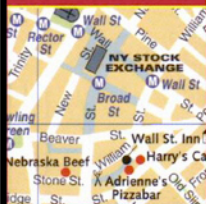

In Williamsburg, a neighborhood stuck in the hipster boom that defined it at the turn-of-the-millennium, a beacon of uptown elegance appears in Colin Devlin's Dressler. Not in the aesthetic of the place, mind you, which, like its local sister restaurants, DuMont and DuMont Burger, bleeds Brooklyn-cool—the cavernous space is a former printers shop redesigned into a glossy haunt, with mosaic tiles, polished mahogany and zinc-topped bar.

But in Chef Polo Dobkin's finely-tuned cuisine, which turns contemporary American fare on its pretty little head. Cool cubes of pickled watermelon find their way into a dish of pan-roasted quail and gooey cheese grits; and a perfectly-crisped roast chicken, studded with Crayola-bright veggies, gets hit with a sauce reduction impressive enough to raise a French eyebrow or two.
